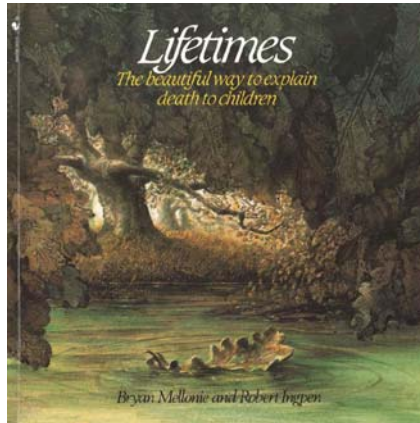
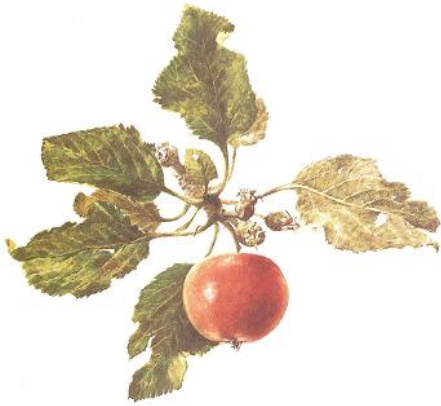


# *Lifetimes: The Beautiful Way to Explain Death to Children*
